

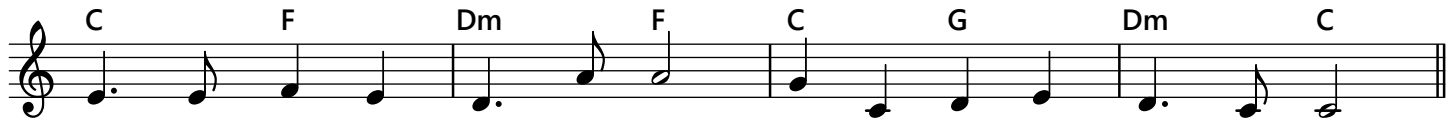

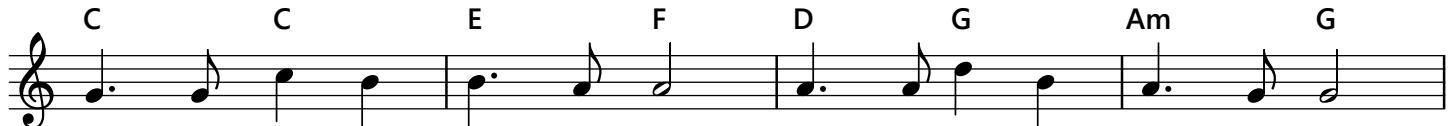


1. Hail, Re - deem - er, King di - vine! Priest and Lamb, the throne is thine,
