

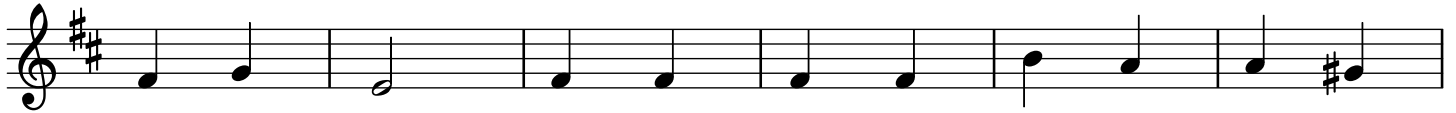

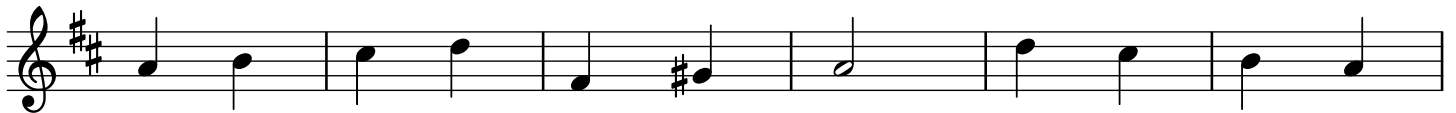

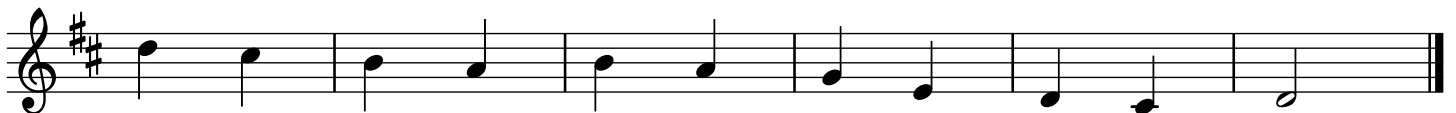
1. Praise, my soul, the King of heav - en; to his feet thy
