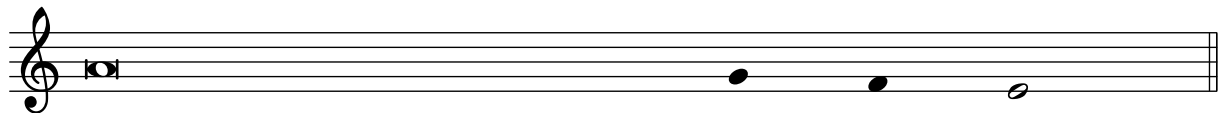
1. The Lord's is the earth and its fullness,
