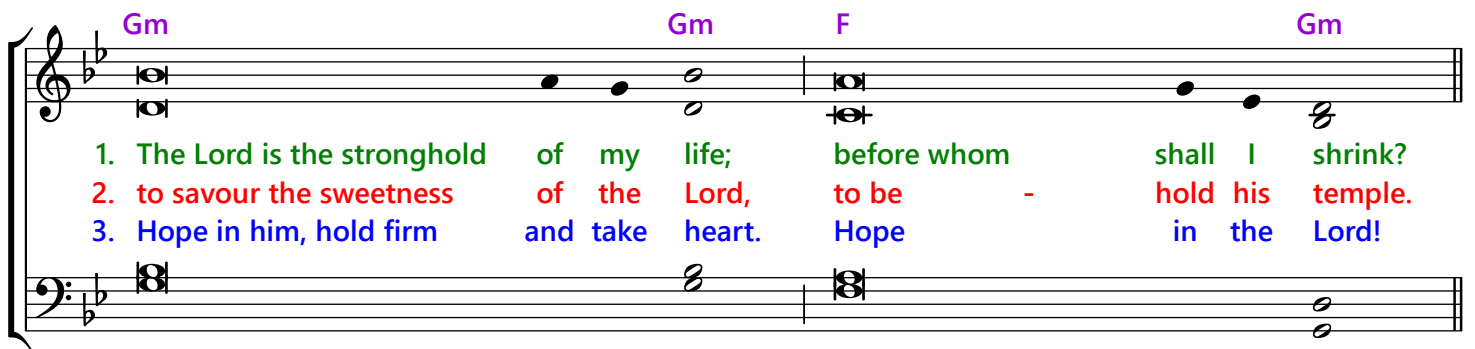
Psalm 27 (26): 1, 4, 13-14
