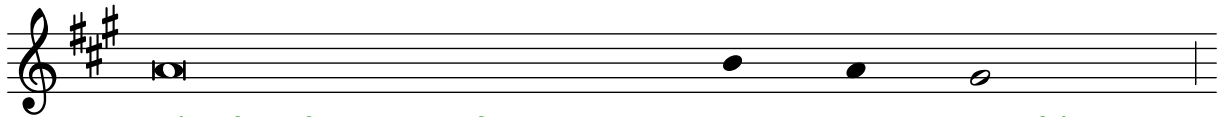

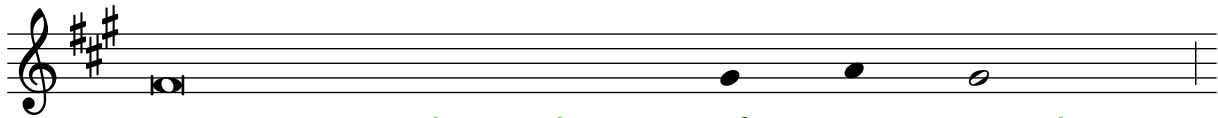

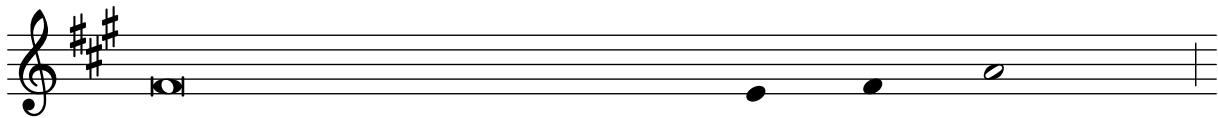
Psalm 78 (77): 1b-2, 34-35, 36-37, 38



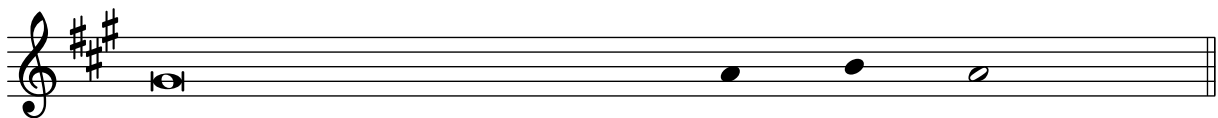
